	Portable Score Board	Diedra didn't have any new information. The cost for a good one would be around \$3,000 (to be portable and of a good size). This is something that could be used for multiple sports (soccer, lacrosse, baseball, softball, etc.).	Tabled until 1/2016
	Discount Cards	We broke even (by about \$20); still have a lot left to sell. Some discussion was held about possibly changing the dates instead of running May to May.	
	Sponsorships	We have been approached by a couple businesses who would like to donate to DSB. We would like to accept these donations and place banners for the sponsors. A.D. Ford says the school is open to it; location to hang them inside may be an issue; school board may be tough to deal with.
