	Attendance and Approval of Minutes	A motion was made by Lance Cole to approve the minutes from the August meeting; seconded by Margie Hamberg; motion passed.	
	Treasurer's Report	Reviewed the financial report as of August 31, 2017, with a checkbook balance of \$25,215.39. Dawn Gonzalez made a motion to approve the budget; seconded by Margie Hamberg; motion passed.	
	Old Business Fundraising	Online store: It was mentioned, just so everyone is aware, that Specialty Trophy now has Dryden apparel.	
	Committee Reports Concessions	Wendy discussed the issue of needing permits in the stand. The Health Department is going to start checking on these with schools. She signed up for individual permits for the Fall season (up to 8 events are covered). There is no charge for these for not-for-profits. At least one person in the stand has to take a test. The Health Department will inspect. Some issues they brought up: they require us to get water from the school, have a hand washing station, on-site prep (no cooking food at home ahead of time – except baked goods); suggested putting bleach in soap water for cleaning up, etc. If the Recreation Department wants to use the stand, they will have to get permits, too.

	<p>New Business</p>	<p>Homecoming and Hall of Fame: Larry Hinkle discussed Homecoming and asked if DSB would pay for spaghetti dinners for Hall of Fame Inductees.</p> <p>Motion was made by Wendy Shipman to pay up to \$180.00 for the Hall of Fame inductees and guests spaghetti dinners on homecoming night; seconded by Lance Cole; motion passed. (Exact amount will be forwarded to DSB after the event and paid at that time.)</p> <p>Larry Hinkle handed out information on the sports programs, showing the number of students in the various sports. There is 39% of students in grades 7-12 participating in athletics.</p> <p>Larry Hinkle brought up other ideas/thoughts/suggestions: (1) Iron Mind program – are we going to continue it? (2) Fall posters are in the works; will have coaches come and pick photos to use. It was suggested to use team pictures instead of individuals. Maybe place team pictures in the concession stand as well? (3) he would like students to do “colorful” commentary in the morning announcements. (4) Discussed “cube” – an online streaming program where you can film games live as long as there is Wi-Fi.</p>
