	Treasurer's Report	Reviewed the budget as of the end of January. We had a great year for concession sales. We brought in \$1,276 from the Dryden Recreation tournament. Talked about the need to move to QuickBooks in conjunction with moving the budget to a new person. Jerry and/or Lance would be happy to meet with anyone who would like to get more information on how the budget works. Wendy Shipman made a motion to approve the budget; seconded by Lisa Cavataio; motion passed.	
	Old Business	<p>Fundraising ideas: An e-mail went out prior to the meeting asking for feedback on fundraising ideas. We talked about four:</p> <p>Online store for Dryden gear – We had a good discussion on this topic. Making one place for everyone to get gear would consolidate buying power; offer consistency of sizing and an opportunity to brand. A sport would get the percentage of gear purchased specifically for that sport. Any general Dryden gear purchased that was not sport specific could go into a general athletic fund.
